- Manage and carry out customer quality activities such reviewing customer requirements, creating PPAP documentation, complaint handling and customer audits.
- Working with the engineering and manufacturing teams to develop and use quality inspection and control documentation.
- Working with the procurement team to manage supplier quality.
- Drive simplification and standardisation of quality processes.
- Initially this role will include hands-on QC activities with the manufacturing and engineering teams. Part of your role will be to identify what additional resources we need to meet our quality requirements and this may include recruiting a Quality Engineer / Technician as a direct report into this role.

You will work closely with all areas of the business including Engineering, Purchasing, Accounts and Manufacturing, across all of our sites (Lutterworth, Northampton and Großostheim, Germany) and some travel is to be expected both within the UK and abroad depending on the project requirements.
